

# ***Baby Blanket***

*designed by Debbie Scheinkman for Sticks and Strings*

\*may be done in any weight yarn. Multiply the number of stitches per inch by the width you'd like to blanket to be. Use an odd amount of sts.

Cast on desired amount of sts and do 20 rows in seed stitch (every row is k1, p1 across the row).

Repeat the next 4 rows until the blanket is 20 rows short of the desired length.

Row 1: 11 seed st, place marker, knit to last 11 sts, place marker, 11  
ss

Row 2: 11 ss, slide marker (sm), purl to last 11 sts, sm, 11 ss

Row 3: 11 ss, sm, k1, p1 across to marker, sm, 11 ss

Row 4: 11 ss, sm, purl to last 11 sts, sm, 11 ss

Do 20 more rows of seed stitch.

Bind off.
